## #WCCCHAMPS QUICK HITS

★ Two WCC pitchers rank in the top-10 nationally in strikeouts: Gonzaga's **Eli Morgan** (4th/128) and Loyola Marymount's **Cory Abbott** (4th/119). **Morgan** is also the active NCAA Division I leader in shutouts with 5.

★ **Morgan** ranks 17th among NCAA Division I career leaders in strikeouts (271) and is 27th in victories (20) along with Saint Mary's **Johnny York**.

★ **BYU's Colton Shaver** ranks 16th among active NCAA Division I players in home runs with 34. Three WCC hitters rank in the top-25 nationally in doubles: San Diego's **Roman Garcia** (12th/22), **BYU's Brennon Anderson** (23rd/21) and Santa Clara's **Jake Brodt** (23rd/21).

★ Saint Mary's **Zach Kirtley** ranks 21st nationally in walks with 44 on the season.

★ **BYU's Brock Hale** ranks 4th among active NCAA Division I players in career batting average hitting .377 and is also 5th in career slugging percentage with a career mark of .670.

★ **BYU** ranks in the top-25 nationally in multiple team offensive categories, including batting average (5th/.325), scoring (5th/8.4), hits (8th/617), home runs per game (21st/1.25), runs (13th/427), on-base % (18th/.399), sacrifice flies (2nd/36), slugging % (9th/.499).

★ Two WCC teams rank in the top-25 nationally in team earned run average: Gonzaga (19th/3.45) and Loyola Marymount (23rd/3.48)

★ Four WCC student-athletes earned a spot on the 2017 CoSIDA Academic All-District 8 First Team: Gonzaga's **Sam Brown** (Physical Education) and **Daniel Fredrickson** (Mechanical Engineering) and Pepperdine's **Aaron Barnett** (Economics) and **Matt Crowder** (Economics).

### WCC Baseball Bullets

★ No. 22 **Gonzaga** and No. 27 **Loyola Marymount** earned spots in this week's Collegiate Baseball Poll

★ For the second time in two seasons, the WCC ERA single-season record was shattered. WCC Pitcher of the Year **Cory Abbott** of Loyola Marymount posted a 0.27 ERA besting the Pepperdine All-American **A.J. Puckett**, who posted a 0.40 ERA in 2016. San Francisco All-American **Dana Hendershott** held the conference single-game ERA mark since recording a 0.60 mark in 1971.

★ Loyola Marymount's **Cory Abbott** ranks eighth among Division I ERA leaders at 1.58 and is 13th in WHIP (0.90).

★ Saint Mary's Fr. UTL **Kevin Milam** was named National Player of the week by Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA. **Milam** homered in three straight games with two grand slams.

## 2017 WEST COAST CONFERENCE BASEBALL HONORS

### WCC Player of the Year - Riley Adams, San Diego

Riley Adams is the fourth San Diego student-athlete to capture WCC Player of the Year honors since 2013, joining three Toreros drafted in the first round of the Major League Draft: Kyle Holder (2015), Connor Joe (2014) and 2016 National League MVP Kris Bryant (2011). Adams hit .380 with nine doubles, eight home runs and 25 RBI during WCC action. Adams led the league in slugging (.710) and was second in on-base percentage (.476) was fourth in homers. The 10th San Diego student-athlete to capture Player of the Year honors, Adams helped a starting rotation comprised of a freshman and two sophomores post the third-best team ERA in the conference in 2017.

### WCC Pitcher of the Year - Cory Abbott, Loyola Marymount

Cory Abbott turned in one of the most dominant seasons in Loyola Marymount and WCC history as a junior. Named to the National Pitcher of the Year Watch List, Abbott posted a sparkling 8-0 record with a record-setting 0.27 ERA during WCC play. Abbott tossed the first perfect game in WCC and LMU history against BYU (3/25/17) and posted scoreless innings streaks of 43.0 innings and 18.2 innings while allowing just two earned runs in 67.0 innings during league play. Abbott struck out 102 and walked only 14 and opposing hitters managed a paltry .127 batting average. Abbott is the fifth Lion to win Pitcher of the Year and the first since Stephen Kahn in 2004.

### WCC Defensive Player of the Year - Daniel Schneemann, BYU

Daniel Schneemann enjoyed a strong season up the middle for BYU and collected Defensive Player of the Year honors. The shortstop committed three errors en route to a .978 fielding percentage and recorded 90 assists during league play. Schneemann helped BYU finish second in team defense among conference leaders (.977). The sophomore batted .274 with 30 runs, five doubles, triple and 14 RBI.

### WCC Freshman of the Year - Keaton Kringlen, BYU

Kevin Milam started every game, batting .271 with 18 runs, four doubles, seven home runs and 26 RBI. The infielder finished his first WCC campaign with a flourish, belting three home runs – two of them grand slams – to lift SMC to a series sweep to secure a WCC tournament berth. Milam is the fourth Gael named Freshman of the Year and the first since Troy Channing in 2009.

### WCC Coach of the Year - Mark Machtolf, Gonzaga

Mark Machtolf earns his third Coach of the Year honor after guiding Gonzaga to its third regular season WCC title in five seasons. The Bulldogs went 31-19, 20-7 in WCC play. Gonzaga ranked second in team ERA (3.11) and fourth in team batting (.288) during league contests. Machtolf, who collected his 400th career win this season, became just the fifth coach in WCC history to collect 200 league triumphs, good for fifth place.

Eight of 10 member institutions have competed in the WCC Championship: BYU (2013, 15-17), Gonzaga (2013-14, 16-17), Loyola Marymount (2014-15, 17), Pepperdine (2014-16), Saint Mary's (2016-17), San Diego (2013, 15), San Francisco (2013) and Santa Clara (2014).

Three of 2013's West Coast Conference major award winners made their Major League debuts in 2015 and all three competed in the 2013 WCC Championship.

### AFTER FURTHER REVIEW

The West Coast Conference was the first Division I conference to implement replay use during the 2014 WCC Baseball Championship at Banner Island Ballpark. The NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel approved the request from the WCC. Replay protocol is identical to what has been adopted for the College World Series. The WCC utilized replay during the 2015 and 2016 events with one implementation in each tournament.

### 2017 WCC NOTABLES

#### FIVE AT 30-WINS

Entering the WCC Championship, five league teams have posted at least 30 wins, while San Francisco posted 29. The last time five WCC teams posted at least 30 wins was 2008: San Diego (44), Pepperdine (38), Santa Clara (33), San Francisco (31) & Gonzaga (30).

### 2017 WCC TRI-CHAMPIONS

For the second time in league history, three teams shared the regular season title with BYU, Gonzaga and Loyola Marymount each posting identical 20-7 league records. It is the second straight year that both BYU and Gonzaga have earned at least a share of the WCC title, while this is the first time since 2000 that Loyola Marymount is regular season champions. It is the second straight year that there has been tri-champions, with BYU, Gonzaga, and Saint Mary's sharing the title a season ago.

# WCC in the College World Series



The WCC has been represented four times at the College World Series since the event began in 1947. Santa Clara was the first league squad to play for the NCAA title in Omaha, as the Broncos rebounded from a loss in their first game to reel off four straight wins and reach the 1962 championship game. Santa Clara, who was led by the CWS Most Outstanding Player in pitcher Bob Garibaldi, played three extra inning contests in the College World Series including a 15-inning loss to Michigan in the title game. Pepperdine made its first College World Series appearance in 1979, finishing in third place by winning three straight games before falling in the semifinals. The WCC enjoyed some of its greatest baseball success in the late 1980's and early 1990's, and LMU began the period with its first College World Series appearance in 1986. Led by several future Major Leaguers, the Lions achieved a No. 1 national ranking on April 22 of that season and went on to represent the WCC at Rosenblatt Stadium. Pepperdine capped off the era with the conference's first-ever national championship in baseball, claiming the College World Series title in 1992. The Waves reeled off four straight victories in Omaha, including a 3-2 triumph over Cal State Fullerton in the championship game.

# WCC Championship Series



In its first decade, the WCC Championship Series has provided fans with exciting moments that have highlighted the best of West Coast Conference baseball. Since its inception, six players that participated in Championship Series events have gone on to reach the Major Leagues, while eight players have earned the distinction of being selected in the first round of the annual Major League Baseball Draft. In all, 18 WCC baseball teams have advanced to the NCAA Tournament since the conference instituted a two-division alignment in 1999. The league returned to a single division format prior to the 2006 season, but retained the Championship Series, pitting the top two teams in the conference standings against one another.
